About Jersey War Tunnels (JWT)

Dug deep into the hillside by forced and slave workers from nations across Europe, JWT now contains an underground collection of thought-provoking exhibits that tell the fascinating story of Jersey's occupation from resistance, through to starvation, then eventual liberation.

JWT tells the stories of people who experienced life under German occupation, told first hand or passed down the generations in local families. The exhibitions tell tales of everyday life, surprising events and often unexpected situations - but always the human story, of people surviving and living their life under extraordinary circumstances.

JWT is made up of the 1,000 metre underground tunnel complex, which houses the award winning exhibition, a visitor centre, the Garden of Reflection as well as two escape room experiences, all on a 29.5 acre site in the heart of the Jersey countryside.
